


The first question was answered correctly by majority, which shows that people are informed about natural beauty of Croatia.



Croatian National Park inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list (in 1979) as a natural property is: (Plitvice Lakes)






The second question was also answered correctly by majority , which shows that they are familiar with Croatian pearl of the nature.




3. The youngest *National Park* in Croatia is: (Velebit)




